We will also be attempting to create an organized


central file for all the Request/Approvals under each home.

IMPORTANT MEETING

On Wednesday April 17th the Masters Board of Directors will be holding their monthly meeting at THE PATIOS CLUBHOUSE beginning at 6:00 PM followed immediately by a presentation by Molly Holland and the Masters Lakes Committee members. Molly Holland is the Sarasota County NEST coordinator (Neighborhood Environmental Stewardship Team). Molly will be speaking

about our community's responsibility to maintain our Stormwater Retention Pond System, the importance of treating stormwater runoff, and how we can meet the county's water quality requirements and goals.

At the conclusion of Molly's presentation, the Lakes Committee will present an overview of the current 2024 Filter Lake repair project and the proposed 2025 Lake 11 (tennis court lake) repair project. At that time, Lakes Committee members will be available to take questions regarding the project and any potential impact on homeowners on the Way and the Drive whose property adjoins the lake.

I cannot stress enough about the importance of this opportunity to address any questions and concerns that Lake 11 property owners have at this open forum, and I urge you to attend the meeting in person.

Happy spring everyone! The weather is beautiful, perfect for walking and outdoor activities. Especially working in your gardens! Now is the time to do that work before the heat and humidity arrives.

Reminder- you must get a written approval from grounds BEFORE any changes are made in your enclosed gardens and tree removal or tree additions. No palms will be planted this year due to a fungus here that kills them, for which there is no treatment.

If you are a snowbird getting ready to go back to your home in other states, be sure to secure the outside by picking up lawn chairs, etc. that could become a hazard in high winds.

There are two new supervisors for West Coast landscaping. W/C is part of Sunrise landscaping. We are looking forward to working with them. There also will be Sunrise trucks and West Coast trucks here in the community.

Watering instructions will be delivered to everyone on the list. Hand watering along with the regular weekly irrigation system is a must as the new sod will die without it.

We will also be replacing dead and dying shrubs this month.

The grounds committee has lots to do after the unusually long cold winter season that has interfered with our plans.

Monthly grounds meetings on the first Tuesday of the month at 10 am at the clubhouse.
